Public Notice of CCNE Accreditation Review and Call for Third Party Comments

In accordance with the standards and guidelines of the CCNE, programs seeking accreditation are required to evaluate their program according to several core standards. One of the requirements for accreditation specifies that the program notify their constituents and communities of interest of the opportunity to submit written third-party comments to the CCNE. All third-party comments submitted to CCNE must be written in English, consistent with CCNE's policy on Conduct of Business in English. These written and signed third-party comments will be accepted by CCNE up to 21 days (on or before October 30, 2024) prior to the scheduled visit. All comments must include the name, address, and phone number of the person providing the comments.

CCNE shares third party comments with members of the evaluation team prior to the visit, but at no time during the review process are these comments shared with the program. During its review, the evaluation team will consider all third party comments that relate to the accreditation standards.
